I wanted to let you know what we are currently doing to try to alleviate the traffic issue at morning drop-off. I am in contact with the city trying to get our yellow barriers reinstalled at the corner of Hogan and College. CELL PHONES IN SCHOOL ZONES - AR ACT 37: As of October 1, 2011, a driver of a motor vehicle *shall not use a handheld wireless telephone while operating a motor vehicle when passing a school building or school zone during school hours when children are present and outside the building* unless making an emergency call to fire, police or other emergency personnel. Use of a "Handheld wireless telephone" means a wireless interactive communication device with which a user engages in communication using at least one (1) hand. 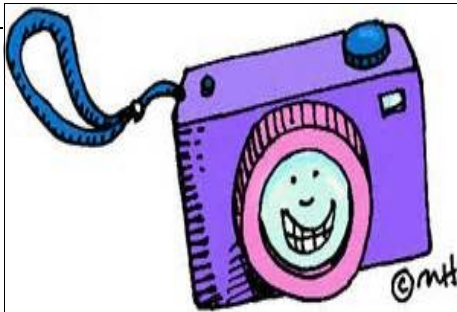

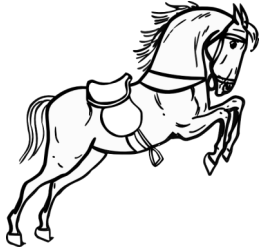

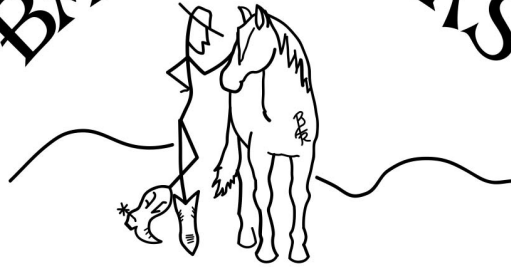
