- motivate students to "want" to attend school during that - last month of school when things are winding down. I'd - like to give you a bit of a heads up so you'll have time to - voice concerns about this activity. I've listed below the activities involved and the skills taught. Please let me . know if you have questions or concerns. I promise this is " not a scary thing more like the movie, "Monster's Inc."
Kids that have been involved in this begin asking in Sep-- tember; "When is the
"monster coming back to the G. T. classroom?"
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Week 1 - Sequencing/Observation - the students will enter the room and follow the "monsters" footprints around - the classroom to find clues of the nine to twelve messes - the monster made.
-Week 2 - Sketch Artist/How to ask a good question - the - students must use the clues from the previous week and . ask yes and no questions to determine what the monster looks like. Then they draw the monster.

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Week 3 - Left Brain Logic - students exercise the left side of the brain to solve logic problems that give them even more information about the monster.


Self control means being able to control your actions
-Week 4 - The Trap/Problem Solving - the final week is - spent building a friendly trap to catch the monster to let him know that he is always welcome in the G. T. room, but has to clean up the messes he makes.
