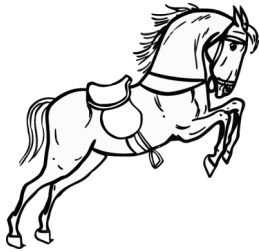

7. An email will pop up to Mrs. Bentley. Click “send.”
