- \*Friday, November 2: "SHADE out Drugs" (wear sunglasses)

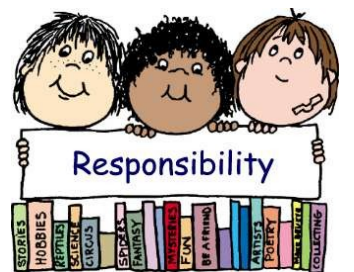

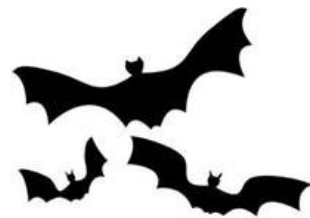
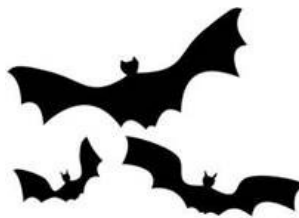
Jim Stone Elementary, Blue Ribbon Character kids raised \$621.60 that will be donated to:
