There are several ways you can help:

Gather your box tops and tape/glue to the

sheet and return to school. Your name will be entered into a monthly drawing for a small prize when you return a completed sheet (50 Box Tops). The bonus box tops need to be returned in a separate Ziploc. Our school earns .10 cents for every box top. There are a lot of Bonus Box Tops out there right now on products like Cheerios, Totinos Pizza, Pillsbury Cinnamon Rolls, Avery products, Fiber One, Betty Crocker, Ziploc etc... so look on your packages.

2.Sign up online to be on their email list at www.boxtops4education.com
-Click on EARN and scroll down to BONUS Box Tops then click on BE A BOX TOP HERO. Our school earns .50 for every person that registers so spread the word! Deadline is this Saturday-September 15th so please sign up today!

Our school can earn **another** .50 by clicking on EARN then scroll down to BONUS --5 eBT new email opt-in-marketplace.

- 3.Shop through the Marketplace. www.boxtops4education.com Click on EARN then scroll down to **shop marketplace** and you will see all of the stores. You click on the store and shop at **no extra cost to you**. Box Tops will automatically give our school a percentage of your total. It is that easy! You can also find coupons and promotional sales. So far our school has earned 13.00 this year just from people shopping through this website. There are over 175 stores to choose from-Snapfish, iTunes, Walmart, Apple Store, Hotels.com, Walgreens, Home Depot, Nike, K Mart, Lands' End, Shoe Buy, Company Kids, Oriental Trading Company.....

The winning class will be announced over the intercom (monthly) and there is a traveling trophy that will be given to the class that collects the most Box Tops each month. Also, the winning class will receive a 15 minute extra recess!
